- I. Work pledged. Because of the expected project cost, the City of Cold Spring (the “City”) is required to obtain quotes for the Work. The undersigned (the “Bidder”) proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to perform and furnish all Work for the City as specified or indicated in the specifications and Special Provisions for the Contract Price and within the Contract Time indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract Documents.
- II. Terms accepted. The Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Bid Form and Specifications and Special Provisions.
- III. Bid Security and Performance Bond. The City will not require Bid Security for this project. The successful bidder must provide a performance bond equal to the amount of the Bid and execute an Agreement provided by the City for the Work; if the successful Bidder fails to execute and deliver the Agreement and furnish the required performance bond within 15 days of receiving notice of the award of the Work, the City may at its sole discretion annul the award.
- IV. Representations. In submitting this Bid, the Bidder represents that:
  - A. The Bidder has examined copies of all specifications and this bid form.
  - B. The Bidder familiarized itself with the nature and extent of the specifications Work, site locality, and all local conditions and Laws and Regulations that in any manner may affect cost, progress, performance, or furnishing of the Work.
  - C. The Bidder has obtained and carefully studied (or assumes responsibility for obtaining and carefully studying) all such examinations, investigations, explorations, tests and studies (in addition to or to supplement those referred to in (c) above which pertain to the physical conditions at the site or otherwise may affect the cost, progress, performance or furnishing of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Time and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the specifications.

- D. The Bidder has given the **Public Works Director** written notice of all conflicts, errors or discrepancies that it has discovered in the specifications and the written resolution thereof by **Public Works Director** is acceptable to the Bidder.
- E. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm or corporation and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation; the Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other bidder to submit a false or sham Bid; the Bidder has not solicited or induced any person, firm or corporation to refrain from bidding; and the Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other bidder or over the City.
- V. Work. The Work to be included in the bid shall consist of the tasks indicated here and as specified in addendums prepared prior to the bid opening, if any. Payment will be based upon the final pounds of sealer utilized in performing the Work installed and in place, at the bid unit prices; there shall be no payment made for other materials utilized, labor employed, or related expenses incurred in performing the Work.
- **Route cracks 6” – 10” from road edge.**
  - **Route cracks 1” wide by ¾” deep**
  - **Clean & dry cracks with high volume compressed air from a hot air lance.**
  - **Blow all routing debris to edge of street for city removal.**
  - **Seal cracks with Mn/Dot Spec 3723 – Hot rubberized sealer**
  - **Flush fill all cracks.**
  - **Seal 1 ½” – 2” wide over ban outside edge of crack.**
  - **Glensoil preferred, but paper cover acceptable.**
- VI. Time Schedule. Work shall be done no later than **Friday, August 12, 2024**. The work occurring shall be completed within 10 working days after it commences. The following provision shall apply to scheduling the project:
- A. Prior to starting work, the Contractor shall meet the Public Works Director to discuss the method and means of material and means of material supply, a work schedule, and a general review of the specifications. The Contractor shall notify the Public Works Director of deficient areas prior to performing work in those areas.
- B. The Contractor is responsible for notifying the Public Works Director 72 hours in advance of the crack sealing operations in order to allow the Public Works Director time to distribute notification to the residents restricting parking and use during the crack sealing operation.
- VII. Special Provisions. The City at times identifies provisions unique to a particular project bid, which is referred to as Special Provisions. These Special Provisions, if any, include those listed below, and those that may be included in any addendums distributed prior to the bid opening.
- VIII. Submittal information. Bids may be mailed or delivered to the address above. Bids will be accepted until **11:00 on Monday, July 8, 2024** at City Hall; they will be tabulated immediately after this deadline. All bids must be submitted on this Bid Form in order to be accepted. Bids are generally submitted to the City Council for consideration at their meeting immediately preceding the bid deadline. **The City reserves the right to modify quantities, reject any or all bids, and waive any irregularities.**
